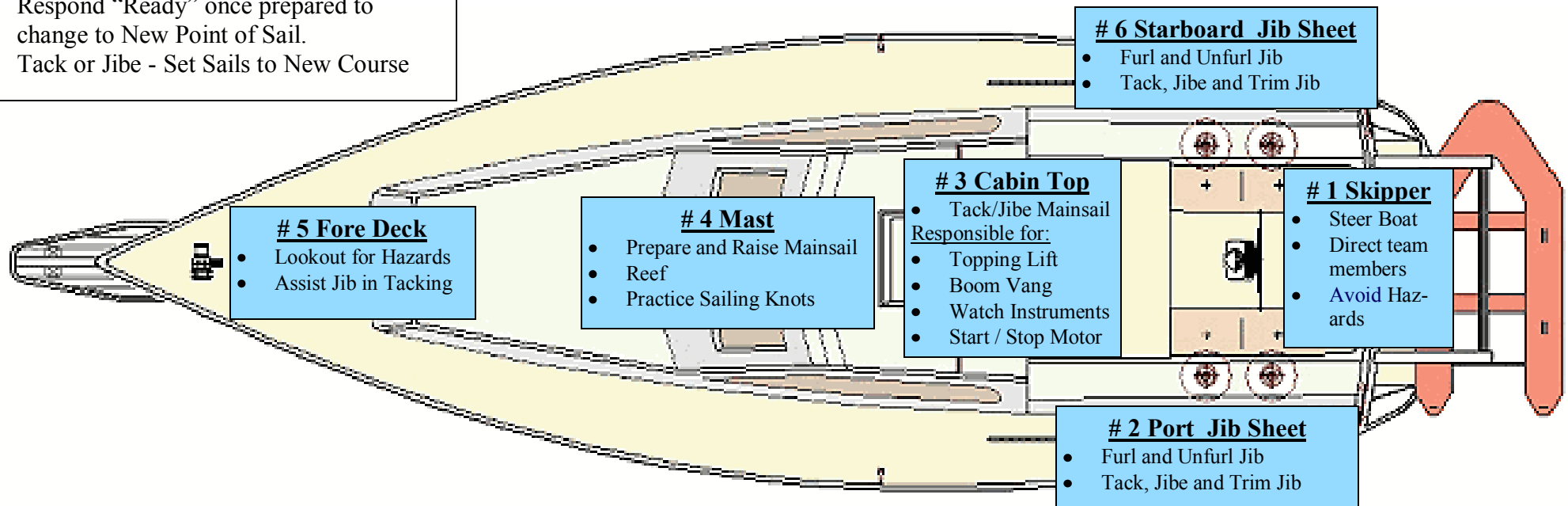


# Gleaming Ocean Student Rotation

## Crew Responsibilities

1. Listen for Skippers Command to Tack or Jibe and New Point of Sail.
2. Respond "Ready" once prepared to change to New Point of Sail.
3. Tack or Jibe - Set Sails to New Course

<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Give Command Standby to Tack or Jibe, and New Point of Sail</li> <li>2. Listen for all crew to respond "ready"</li> <li>3. Yell Tack or Jibe</li> <li>4. Tack or Jibe</li> <li>5. Hold new course</li> </ol>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tack, Jibe and Trim Jib to New Point of Sail</li> </ul> <p style="text-align: center;"><b>Or</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Release Jib Sheet to Tack or Jibe when on Lazy Sheet</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tack, Jibe and Trim Mainsail</li> <li>• Responsible for: Mainsheet, topping lift, boom vang, start and stop motor for skipper, monitor instruments</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Raise Mainsail</li> <li>• Assist Fore Deck</li> <li>• Reef/Un-reef Main</li> <li>• <u>Sailing Knots:</u> Cleat Hitch, Figure Eight, Bowline, Round Turn + Two Half Hitches, Clove Hitch</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Lookout for and Announce boats and hazards</li> <li>• Help Jib (headsail) around Staysail during Tack and Jibes</li> <li>• Watch the Wind for Gusts and Change in Direction</li> </ul>
