SAN FRANCISCO SCHOOL DISTRICT SAILS:

Summer is here and the District sails are on hiatus until Fall...meanwhile, the SF Police are getting their Wilderness Youth Program back on track and the plan is to have officers on our school sails come Fall...their staffing crisis is largely past and they consider this Program of key value to the Department and the City's youth. We hear this from both the Chief and Assistant Chiefs...they recognize what these sails mean to the police and the students.

COMMUNITY SAILS:

Community sails are continuing, and we have many new exciting programs:

- 1. Our program for visually impaired sailors needs additional work to organize and a meeting of the committee working on this will be set up in the next several weeks. So far, Kimberly, Andrew, Mariette, Ben and Judy are planning to participate. You? Anyone interested in participating in this should contact Lee at lstimmel@stimmel-law.com. Keep in mind we are working with Captain Andrew to begin the blind racing team, and also having blind sailors as some of our volunteers on the probation sails. Do we also want a special program working with Light House with blind sailors? That is up to the committee to decide and if you are interested, let's get it going...
- 2. *Project Rebound*, formerly incarcerated adults and interns learning to work with them have a sail on Bear on July 27.
- 3. City of Berkeley has a sail on Benjamin Walters on August 2.
- 4. Silver Springs high school students come all the way from Grass Valley and Another will be scheduled once school begins again.
- 5. APACC (Asian Pacific Islanders American students) have personnel changes and will be rescheduling soon.
- 6. Marin City. Les is reaching out to them to set up more sails.
- 7. SF Casa is next set for July 20 and September 21.
- 8. *Marín City CDC* has met with Jim Stanton and Lee and after two sails plan to schedule more.
- 9. Camp Keff has a donation sail on July 15.

The quickest way to move up the certification ladder...and a lot of fun.

- **1. First Aid and CPR** –Our next class is on **August 24** at the Berkeley Yacht Club. FREE TO VOLUNTEERS, MUCH OF IT ONLINE, AND REQUIRED FOR CERTIFICATION AS CREW AND CAPTAINS. YOU MUST COMPLETE THE ON LINE PORTION BEFORE ATTENDING THE CLASS WHICH HAS THE "HANDS ON" PRACTICE. SIGN UP ON OUR WEBSITE EVENTS PAGE.
- 2. Certification sail on <u>Bear</u> Live MOB practice occurred on June 15. Another to be scheduled soon.
- 3. <u>Benjamin Walters</u> had a <u>night</u> overboard live practice June 21...and it next certification sail is <u>September 14</u>.
- 4. ALETA certification sail is now scheduled for September 7.
- 5. And recall if come on a sail as a guest or crew, make sure the captain checks out your skills and you can move along the certification list.

BOSUN'S REPORT:

GOLDEN BEAR: A leak in the hydraulic ram for the vang requires repair. Bosun Colm has rigged a block and tackle for the baby stay and taken that hydraulic for the vang for now while he repairs the old vang one.

<u>ALETA</u>: Scott just got back the repaired Main, torn in heavy winds, and now is the time to plan a haul out to have the bottom painted and some work on the packing gland. Stay tuned for confirmation of the week that Aleta will be out of the water. All captains are to be reminded to be gentle on the leech when lowering Aleta's main...we are aging that sail too fast.

BENJAMIN WALTERS: The boat's drive has excessive vibration and List Marine was unable to fix even after rebuilding the pillow block. The boat may need work on the Maxi prop or cutlass bearing thus is to be hauled at BMC for that work on **July 21**. Probably out of the water for a week. At Owner expense.

Devine Wind: Two new halyards as Owner expense and ready to race.

Several crew members complained about confusion on board when two or more first captains are on the same sail. As we all know, a boat requires a single captain to handle all emergencies and be the final voice on board...a boat is not a republic or a democracy though the wise first captain listens to advice. For that reason, we will only have a single sign on position for first captain for each sail and if by chance two or more are on board and are confused as to who is first captain, they are to discuss this between them and decide...AND ANNOUNCE TO CREW...before the sail.
