1. First Aid and CPR –Our next class will be on NOVEMBER 23, BERKELEY YACHT CLUB. FREE TO VOLUNTEERS, MUCH OF IT ONLINE, AND REQUIRED FOR CERTIFICATION AS CREW AND CAPTAINS. YOU MUST COMPLETE THE ON LINE PORTION BEFORE ATTENDING THE CLASS WHICH HAS THE "HANDS ON" PRACTICE. SIGN UP ON OUR WEBSITE EVENTS PAGE.

2. Certification sail on Bear NOVEMBER 21, LIVE OVERBOARD DRILL

- 3. <u>Benjamin Walters</u> has a live MOB drill on NOVEMBER 16.
- 4. ALETA has a full certification sail set for NOVEMBER 9.

5. And recall if come on a sail as a guest or crew, make sure the captain checks out your skills and you can move along the certification list.

BOSUN'S REPORT:

<u>GOLDEN BEAR:</u> After much work and many attempts, the hydraulics cannot be resealed and we have to purchase a new plunger...the Board approved 3800 to do it and ideally it will be fixed in time for the next certification sails and the many school sails coming up.

ALETA: Captain Scott fixed the transmission leak (loose bolts) and she is now reliable as well as exciting.

BENJAMIN WALTERS: New bag for gennaker ordered...owner expense.

Captain Scott has developed a check list for Aleta for captains to review when taking the boat out and putting it away and Bear and Benjamin are doing the same.



OCEAN VOYAGES TRAINING

nursing from USF, was the selected student speaker at his graduation, and has agreed to work with Blue Water and Sategna to help others follow his footsteps.
